INVITATION

Dear Colleagues,

We would like to invite you to participate in the 2026 meeting which will be held in Philadelphia, PA, June 14-18, 2026. We believe that this meeting will offer an exceptional opportunity to interact with our membership in an informal setting, discussing issues of critical importance to thoracic imaging.

We are an international society comprised of more than 85 of the world's leading radiologists, respiratory physicians, oncologists, pathologists, and physiologists from 15 countries. Membership is by invitation, and our members have had a major role in advancing the field. Our White Papers provide foundational guidance for clinical practice and research in multiple areas, including idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis, COPD, lung cancer and pulmonary hypertension (available at <https://fleischner.memberclicks.net/>). The Fleischner White Paper on management of lung nodules is the most-viewed article on the website of Radiology. Topics of recently published white papers include diagnostic criteria for idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis, interstitial lung abnormality, imaging evaluation of pulmonary arterial hypertension, quantitative imaging metrics, and an update of the Fleischner Glossary of Terms for Thoracic Imaging. Many ongoing projects on Quantitative CT, Radiology-Pathology Correlation in Pulmonary Disease, Non-IPF Progressive Pulmonary Fibrosis, Standardized Clinical Terms and Definitions for ILD, and Standardized Reporting of Screen Detected and Incidental Pulmonary Nodules Identified on Chest CT are in preparation. All of these will be discussed at the 2026 meeting.

In addition to the White Papers in development, the meeting will cover a wide range of topics including lung cancer screening, diagnosis, and treatment, early-stage COPD, and Artificial Intelligence. The scientific sessions will present original data, followed by extensive discussions and proposals for future studies, documents or needs for technological development. The overall aim of the sessions is to identify how these fields will move in the next years. In addition, limited opportunities are available for industry partner participation in our round table forums with the Fleischner thought leaders on various topics including lung cancer and Artificial Intelligence. We would be happy to set up a conference call to discuss our program and the synergies between the work of our Society and your area of focus.

The Fleischner Society is an international, multidisciplinary medical society for thoracic radiology, dedicated to the diagnosis and treatment of diseases of the chest. Founded in 1969 by eight radiologists whose predominant professional interests were imaging of chest diseases, the Society was named in memory of Felix Fleischner, an inspiring educator, clinician, and researcher who made many contributions to the field of chest radiology.

The Society was inaugurated in December of 1969 with the following aims:

- To stimulate the recognition and development of chest roentgenology as a clinical specialty
- To foster continuing improvement of chest radiology as an art and science
- To improve the methods of teaching radiologic diagnosis of chest disease
- To promote closer fellowship among, and exchange of ideas between members of the profession whose major interests lie in the chest
- To provide meetings for the reading and discussion of papers, and dissemination of knowledge

The Fleischner Society maintains a diverse membership that includes experts in adult and pediatric radiology, adult and pediatric pulmonary medicine, oncology, thoracic surgery, physiology, quantitative imaging analysis, epidemiology, and other related sciences. The membership supports a primary role of the Society, which is the publication of numerous formal statements that have since been adopted as the standards in the medical field for chest imaging.

The Fleischner Society meets annually for scientific sessions where the latest advances in chest disease diagnosis and treatment are presented and discussed. While the preparation of Fleischner White Papers is a year-round activity, the annual meeting serves as an important touch point for discussion and consensus around these topics.
